**PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 989-2021**

**AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE GOVERNOR, AMADO I. ESPINO III, TO SIGN THE DEED OF DONATION AND RECEIVE 10,000 DOSES OF FLU VACCINE FROM ZUELLIG PHARMA CORPORATION**

**WHEREAS**, one of the primordial concerns of the provincial government of Pangasinan is to address health issues and provide medical service needs of the people, especially during this period of public health emergency crisis;

**WHEREAS**, Zuellig Pharma Corporation is one of the largest healthcare services groups in the country and is offering a broad range of innovative services including distribution of pharmaceuticals;
